1. Exhibition Background

Children are the future of mankind. Art is the purist and most natural way of communication for children as well as an essential quality for their personality growth. Art exchange is of great significance to their healthy development. In order to contribute to the all-around growth of children and promote international exchange in children's arts, as well as to celebrate the 35th anniversary of the Shanghai Children's Foundation and the 15th anniversary of the Shanghai Women and Children Working Committee Office, Shanghai Art Collection Museum, along with other organizations, has decided to hold "Creativity Creates Art" - the 1st International Children's Creative Art Exhibition in the summer vacation in 2016.

As one of the creative cities by the UN, Shanghai has long led in searching for new methods of education to develop children's creative abilities. We expect that this international exhibition will enable children from both home and abroad as well as all sectors of society to enjoy rich and colorful art works from children, improve children's artistic and humanistic accomplishment, and enhance the understanding of respective cultures. In the meantime, we hope that the exhibition can stimulate their artistic enthusiasm, attracting more children to join in the palace of art.

Art education has great influence on children's development. It develops not only children's creativity, imagination and observation abilities but also their personality. This Exhibition will showcase art works by children from home and abroad, invite delegates from these countries to participate, and organize an international forum named 'Art Education and Children's Growth'. The forum intends to invite well-known artists, art education scholars, international organizations of art education and leaders of professional organizations, to have in-depth discussion of relevant issues on children's art education and, with reference to domestic and foreign experience, offer advice and suggestions on better implementing children's art education in order to further improve its effectiveness.

The exhibition will also set up an award system to reward the outstanding works in the exhibition and exploit promising art talents. The awards will be presented on the closing ceremony.

By means of cultural exchange forum, awarding ceremony, publications and art education seminars etc., this exhibition will comprehensively promote the development of children's art education to a higher level.

- 4) Set up an award system of an expert committee and online voting to reward the outstanding children's works, teachers and organizers in the exhibition;
- 5) Host art education seminars etc..

1) Creating at the Exhibition

The awards presented to the best young artists will not only include a certificate but also include a learning experience to the companies and factories.
