REGISTRATION OF BIRTH

Requirements for Registration of Birth

Parents of Filipino babies born in China should first secure the translated, notarized and authenticated birth certificate from the following:

- 1. Notary Public Office (Shanghai) No. 660 Feng Yang Road, Shanghai Tel. No. 8006204848, 621-54848
- 2. Shanghai Foreign Affairs Service Center 2nd Floor, No. 228 Hua Shan Road, Shanghai Office Hours: 1:30—5:30 p.m. M/W/F only Tel. No. 62470833

Once this is secured, present the following to the Consulate General:

- 1. Original and four (4) copies of the notarized and authenticated birth certificate. The baby's footprint should be imprinted on the authentication page of the Foreign Affairs Office.
- 2. Original and four (4) copies of the Philippine Statistics Authority and DFA authenticated Marriage Certificate or Affidavit of Paternity (if not married).
- 3. Five (5) copies of the Passport data page of both parents.
- 4. Duly accomplished FA Form No. 40 Report of Birth form (5 copies, forms are available at the Consulate or can be downloaded at the Consulate's website)
- 5. Fee of RMB360 (includes Authentication of Birth Certificate and Report of Birth).
- 6. Fee of RMB180 (Affidavit of Paternity)
- 7. Fee of RMB180 (Affidavit of Delayed Registration)
- * REPORT OF BIRTH FILED MORE THAN 12 MONTHS AFTER THE CHILD'S BIRTH, AN ORIGINAL AND FOUR COPIES OF NOTARIZED AFFIDAVIT OF DELAYED REGISTRATION MUST ALSO BE SUBMITTED.
