## **REGISTRATION OF BIRTH**

## Requirements for Registration of Birth

Parents of Filipino babies born in China should first secure the translated, notarized and authenticated birth certificate from the following:

- 1. Notary Public Office of the city/province where the child was born
- 2. Foreign Affairs Service Center of the city/province where the child was born

Once this is secured, present the following to the Consulate General:

- 1. Original and four (4) copies of the notarized and authenticated birth certificate. The baby's footprint should be imprinted on the authentication page of the Foreign Affairs Office;
- 2. Original and four (4) copies of the Philippine Statistics Authority and DFA authenticated Marriage Certificate;
- 3. Five (5) copies of the Passport data page of both parents; and
- 4. Duly accomplished FA Form No. 40 Report of Birth form (5 copies, forms are available at the Consulate or can be downloaded at the Consulate's website).
- \* REPORT OF BIRTH FILED MORE THAN 12 MONTHS AFTER THE CHILD'S BIRTH, A NOTARIZED AFFIDAVIT OF DELAYED REGISTRATION MUST ALSO BE SUBMITTED.
