The Philippine Consulate General in Shanghai advises all Filipinos in Shanghai and in the provinces of Anhui, Hubei, Jiangsu, and Zhejiang to guard against illegal recruiters whose latest modus operandi is to post online advertisements in social media informing of job openings in China, such as English teachers, nannies, tutors, mail-order brides, and surrogate mothers, among other things.

Filipinos intending to work in China are reminded to course their application papers through Philippine Overseas Employment Agency (POEA) accredited recruitment agencies.
