WHEN : Start - 13 April 2019, 08:00 AM – 04:00 PM
End - 13 May 2019, 08:00 AM – 06:00 PM
Note: From 13 April – 12 May 2019, the schedule of voting period will be from 08:00 AM – 04:00 PM, Mondays to Sundays.

HOW : Registered overseas voters are required to bring any of the following identification documents to obtain their respective ballots for the national election.

- Voter's ID
- Philippine passport
- Any valid ID bearing the voter's photograph and signature.
